He remembers that, while growing up, he liked to sit quietly in church. He had a natural inclination to stillness and silence.

As an adult he found himself not enamored of the corporate work life. He picked up a bible and read Mt 11:28 "come to me all you who are weary and burdened and I will give you rest." Eventually he met a Paulist priest who was kind of like himself, and imagined that maybe he could be a priest like that. He tried one year at a time of seminary, thinking that he could change his mind after a year. After a year he tried another year.

With COVID he stayed at the Snowmass monastery long enough so that he got used to the monk's rhythm of life and much to his surprise he really likes it, and considers that he should have tried it much earlier but realizes that he had not been ready.

Saint Catherine herself experienced a road block in her vocation journey after her father refused to give her a dowry. However, she kept her trust in the Lord. Soon after, Catherine's brother, Hubert, and Sister-in-law, Jeanne, provided her with the financial support she needed to enter into her vocation. Catherine was then free to become a member of the nursing order founded by Saint Vincent de Paul, The Daughters of Charity.

After a pilgrimage to Compostela, Spain, William lived as a hermit on Monte Vergine, between Nola and Benevento. The disciples who followed him found his life, which included wearing mail, too strict. Not wanted to break up the community or relax his own austerities, William left with a few disciples. He continued to found monasteries until the king of Naples commanded his services as consultant. Those who envied William's influence on the king began to slander him and convinced the king to test William by sending a woman to seduce him. When the woman arrived, William parted the hearth fire with his bare hands, lay down between the embers, and invited her to share his bed. The woman was shocked to repentance and stripped off her jewellery, gave away her possessions, and entered a convent.
